REPORT

A field trip to the National Museum was conducted on 8th Nov 2023 for the students of BA (Hons.) History (Semester-I). The field trip was an essential part of the course to facilitate students' understanding of various themes taught in the course. The field trip was also undertaken as a part of experiential learning for students, where students were to experience multiple cultures of Ancient India while walking along the museum. The activity was also aimed at raising awareness among the students about India's rich and varied heritage and the importance of preserving it. As a part of their Continuous Assessment, the students were to choose an artefact of their choice (preferably from the section on Ancient India), click a geo-tagged photograph with the artefact and submit a write-up of the same. To enable the participation of students with special needs, they were given a sensory experience of selected artefacts, along with a narration on the physical attributes of it. A great amount of time was

spent in Harappan gallery, Maurya and Sunga gallery, Gandhara and Mathura School of Art gallery and Gupta gallery, Chola Bronze gallery, Ragamala paintings gallery and musical instruments gallery. Mr. Sameer Kumar Jha, a student from BA(Hons.) History III year and a talented artist with a keen interest in History, meticulously explained to the students the various sculptures and demonstrated the various positions in which the Chola bronzes were created. Another student from III year History honours, Mr. Neeladri Charles with his impeccable knowledge of Hindustani music and great vocalist, demonstrated for the students various moods of the Ragamala paintings through his renditions. He also explained to the students the evolution of Musical instruments in India. The students were also shown a small documentary in the National Museum auditorium. The students also visited the Virtual experiential museum on the Ajanta caves. Although the long walks across the galleries was a little tiring, the immersive experiences of various themes in History through experiential learning, made it all worth. We ended the day with the promise of curating more such experiences for the students.
