EVENT SUMMARY

The Department of Political Science conducted the first session of its lecture series-Pravaah on the 6th of October 2023 from 11 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. The lecture was on the theme of “PESSIMISM OF THE INTELLECT, OPTIMISM OF THE WILL’: CRITICAL APPROACHES TO SUBALTERN AGENCY.”

Dr. Rina Ramdev, a distinguished speaker from the English department at Sri Venkateswara College, addressed the audience. She oversees the English Literary Association of the college as well as the Women's Development Cell. She has researched post-colonial politics, Arundhati Roy's writings, and the connection between literature and social movements. Additionally, she is involved in researching the connections between political resistance and academic practice in institutional settings. Additionally, she co-edited *Sentiment, Politics, Censorship: The State of Hurt*.

Yuvraj Dhingra, the PSSA executive in charge of social media, gave a welcome speech before introducing the day's speaker. Dr. Haokam's congratulations to the speaker came next. The editorial staff and faculty of the Department of Political Science launched *Loktantra*, their annual magazine, before the lecture. Dr. Haokam then felicitated the speaker and launched the lecture series.

The session, which concentrated on the subaltern school and its agency, was enlightening. Certain groups in society have experienced extreme discrimination, exclusion, or even extinction throughout history. It's often said that the winners write history, but what about the marginalized and voiceless? The Subaltern School seeks to give those who have been silenced a voice due to factors like their socioeconomic status, race, ethnicity, gender, caste, or sexual orientation. The lecture's goal was to contrast the perspective of the elite with that of the marginalized. Antonio Gramsci first used the term "subaltern," which has since come to refer to various characteristics that cause marginalization. Throughout the lecture, the speaker examined various critical theories for comprehending the subaltern school.

After the lecture, the moderator invited audience members to ask questions. After the fascinating question and answer period, Yashica, the president of the political science students' association, gave the session's final vote of thanks. Overall, the

lesson was extremely illuminating and helped the students understand the importance of the subaltern school.
