Event Summary

CounterClaim was one such event that was one of its kind in Introspect 2024 that was based on the premise of Judicial Analysis. Case prompts were sent to the registered teams wherein they had to first submit a writeup (in not more than 2500 words) and then they had to propose an alternative judgment of the case that was allotted to them. Post the submission of the writeups, 5 teams were shortlisted wherein they had to present their alternative judgments to the jury panel on the day of the event (21st March, 2024). The jury panel comprised of Mr. Rahul Ranjan Sir who's an advocate in the Supreme Court of India and High Court of Delhi and Dr. Preeti Singh Ma'am from the Department of Political Science, Sri Venkateswara College. The Audience was left spellbound after seeing the presentations of the shortlisted candidates as it reflected a great amount of in-depth layering and analysis of the judicial cases. A total time of 8 minutes was allocated to every participant post, where there was a Question-Answer round for each candidate from the jury panel and the fellow participants. The jury panel applauded the participants for their remarkable legal and analytical skills. Azmat, Shreya and Shubhadeep (Team 1 from SVC) bagged the 1st Position along with a cash prize of Rs. 1500. Mr. Himanshu Sharma (Participant from IGNOU) bagged the second position securing a cash prize of Rs. 1000. 

4) INTROSPECTMUN'24 Event details


Event Summary

The total number of registered delegates was 46, coming from our college as well as from other colleges across Delhi. The Executive Board members were Ms. Akanksha Vats, Chairperson, Mr. Anhad Singh, Vice Chairperson, and Ms. Saachi Ahuja, Rapporteur. An online training session was provided for the beginners by the Executive Board members, the day before the conference. 
Event Summary




