Prime Minister Modi's section provided insights into his tenure, policies, and contributions to India's development. Notable mentions include:

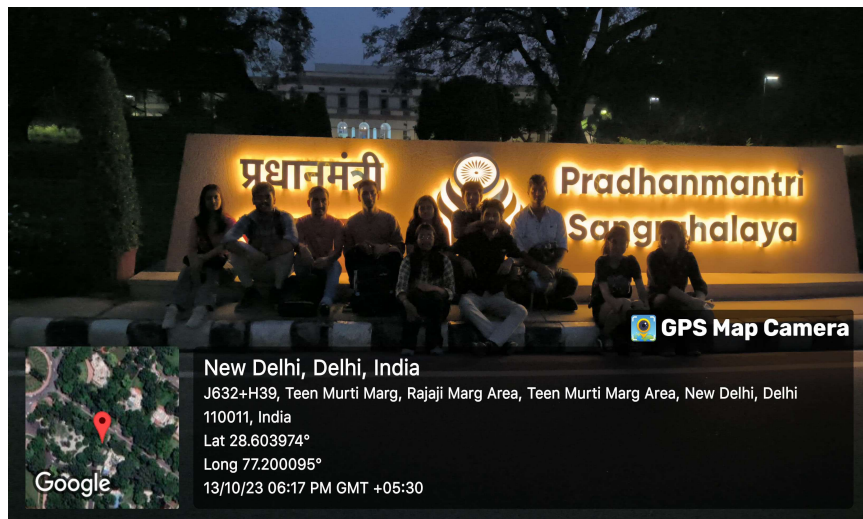
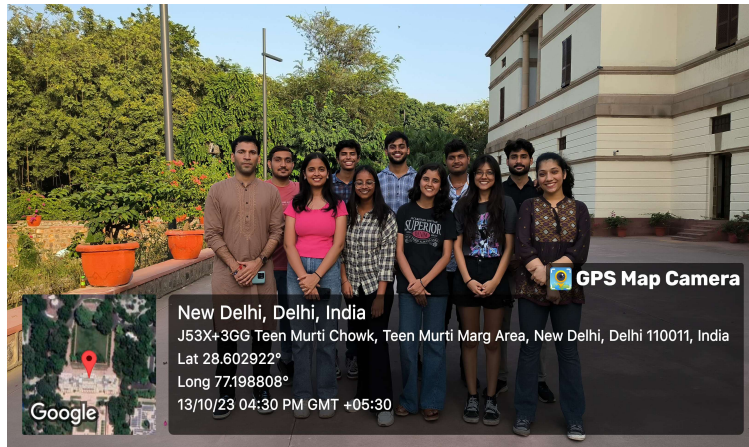
