REPORT OF Three-day online workshop on “Use of AI in Teaching, Learning and Evaluation.”



Inauguration Day-



The inaugural session began with Dr. Pooja Jain enlightening the audience about the relevance and the many paradigms of AI. This was followed by the Saraswati Vandana. Prof. Sharada Pasricha, Convenor of the workshop, extended a warm welcome note highlighting the various aspects of AI. Prof. Swarn Singh, IQAC Coordinator, thereafter spoke about different dimensions of AI. The principal of Sri Venkateswara College, Prof. V. Ravi, mentioned the various challenges concerning the usage of AI in everyday life and the scope of





The second session for Day 1 titled 'AI powered Excel' began at the scheduled hour and continued with a zealous interaction with the audience. The resource person Dr. Ritesh Kumar, Postdoctoral Fellow at the University of Chicago, had a hands-on approach with Excel and the various usages to which it could be put. He demonstrated with great lucidity a very user-friendly set of commands which could enable the audience to achieve several goals.

Dr. Ritesh showed how commands like AI.ASK, could help answer our questions, AI.EXTRACT could help in filling up options, AI.TRANSLATE could help to translate while AI.TABLE could help to lay out data in a tabular form. He further explained with live application, how large sets of data could be analysed and even attendance could be tabulated and calculated with AI in conjunction with Excel. The session received a huge applause from the audience and was followed by an enthusiastic Q&A session. Dr. Rakhi Narang was a great moderator and the session ended with a vote of thanks by Ms. Debarati Sen.






The next session of the three-day online workshop started at 3:00 PM on 23rd May 2024 and continued till 4:30 PM. The keynote speaker for the session was Dr. Arun Julka, Associate Professor, Maharaja Agrasen College, University of Delhi. The session started with the introduction of the resource person by Dr. Pooja Jain, coordinator of the workshop. The resource person carried forward with asking a few questions about the tools used by the faculties for their day-to-day teaching. Furthermore, he continued the hands-on session with the participants, where he explained the usage of tools like Google Drive & how to add the Google Drive extension, Google Earth along with Google Earth Studio, Google Drawings, Paint 3D, MS-Designer & the collaborative working tools. The entire session was interactive and along with the hands-on session, the resource person was also answering the queries of the participants simultaneously. At last, he also explained Google Sites and made participants do a hands-on on Google Sites and create their websites.







The resource person started the session with MS PowerPoint, where he taught how to add speak commands and sections & subsections in the PPT. He also illustrated how Word documents can be converted into PowerPoint presentations, styling PowerPoints, adding 3D effects in PowerPoints, and exporting PPTs to videos. Furthermore, the resource person explained the correct prompt to be used in Chat GPT to get effective results. The resource persons also illustrated other useful tools like Pexels and MS-Powertoys which can help in enhancing the teaching and learning activities. In the end, the session concluded with answering the queries by the resource person and with a vote of thanks to the resource person by Dr. Vinita Kapoor.







The first session of day-3 of the 3- day online workshop started at 3.00 PM on 24th May 2024 and ended up at 4.35 PM. The resource person Dr. Arun Julka, Associate Professor, Department of Mathematics, Maharaja College, University of Delhi, started the session by clearing some queries of participants related to previous session talk. 



He also explained that not only this application is used to generate text but also for Tabular outputs, to make summaries of research papers, to design proposals, etc and many other professional and personal uses in daily life. Sir also explained the Pros and cons of using Chat GPT, mis-use, plagiarism problems etc.


Sir then switched to the use of LMS (Learning Management System) which is very useful for teachers for creating lesson plans, taking assessment, tracking attendance, tracking assignment submissions and many more features. He demonstrated an LMS <https://myclass.academy> to our participants.






