The speakers Ms. Parishkriti Atri and Mr. Rahul Sharma, talking about how to present oneself in an interview. Then she stated the reasons why one should opt for consulting which included all the benefits of being a consultant. Further the speaker mentioned all the skills that one should possess for being a successful consultant.

For example: Situational Based, where the purpose is to test analytical ability, creativity and ability to think logically of the interviewee. Participants got to know about the concepts like what-if situations, brain teasers, puzzles, guess the number. The speaker concluded the session by giving some case studies to students and opening the floor for any questions.



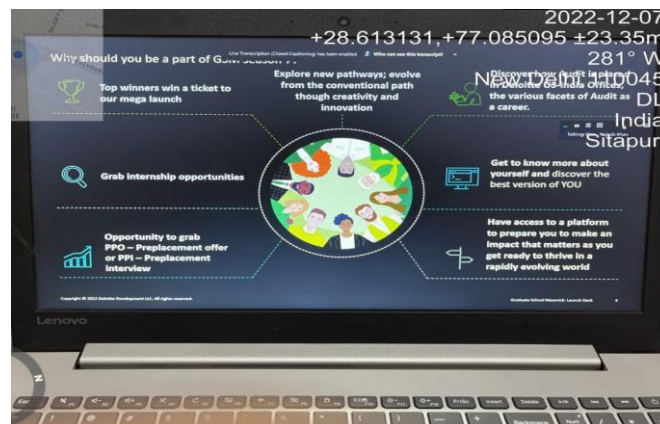
**SEMINAR ON RESUME BUILDING & ONLINE PERSONAL BRAND MANAGEMENT BY

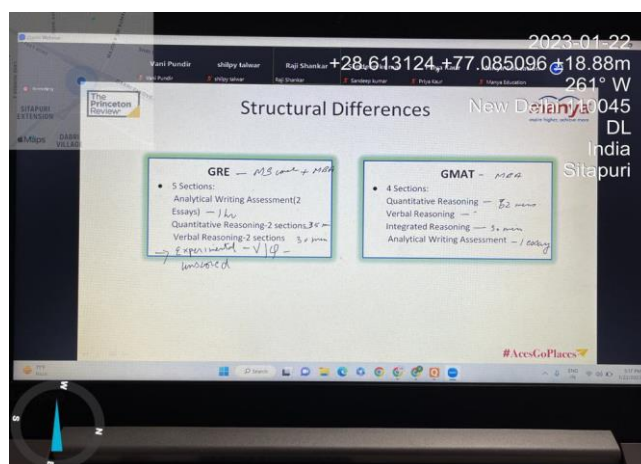
**WEBINAR ON GRADUATE SCHOOL MAVERICK 2022 BY

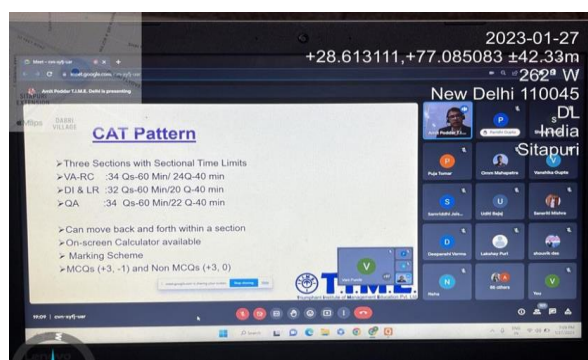

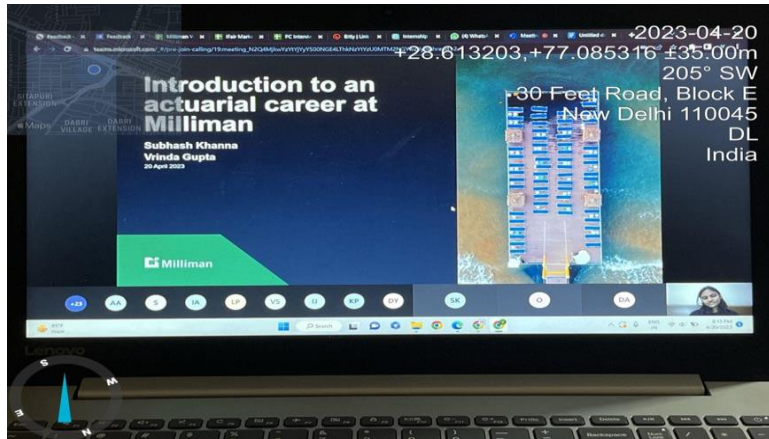
**SEMINAR ON HOW TO SOLVE CASE STUDIES AND GUESSTIMATES BY T.I.M.E**
