Steps to Create a GOOGLE SCHOLAR PROFILE

Your individual Google Scholar profile will allow you to showcase your academic publications and also check and graph citations over time.

Sign in to your Google account.

(If you do not have a Gmail account, please create one)

After signing into your Google account, visit <https://scholar.google.com>

Click on 'My Profile' on the top left-hand corner. Check the spelling of your name. Then enter your complete institutional affiliation - (SRI VENKATESWARA COLLEGE, UNIVERSITY OF DELHI), your institutional email address, your areas of interest, etc.

Track citations to your publications. Appear in Google Scholar search results for your name.

Name:
Use your full name as it appears on your papers. For example: Margaret Mead

Affiliation:
For example: Professor of Computer Science, Stanford University

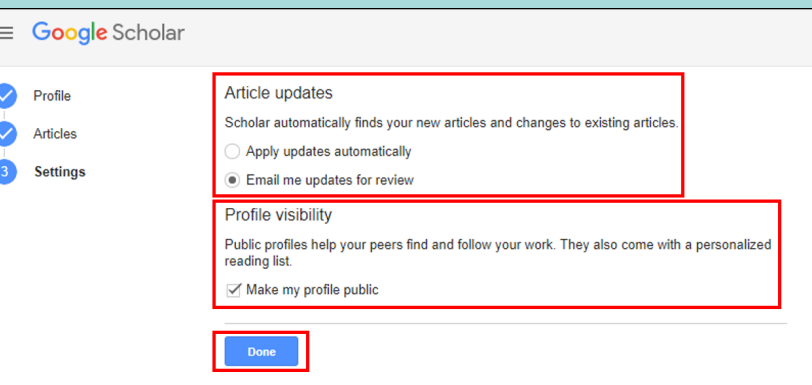
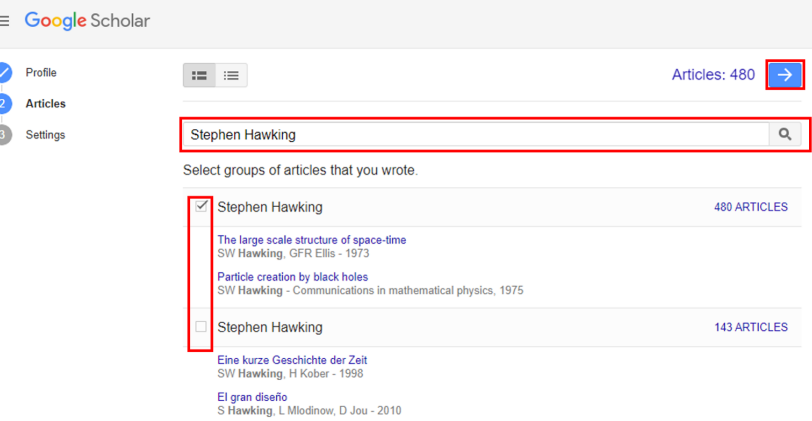
Email for verification:
Use an email address at your institution. For example: yourname@mit.edu

Areas of interest:
For example: Artificial Intelligence, Conservation Biology, Pricing Theory

Homepage:
For example: http://example.edu/~yourname

In the next step, you'll see groups of articles written by people with names similar to yours. Check carefully and add/ select (tick) all articles that you have written. Once you have added your articles, select if you want updates to be applied to your profile automatically, or if you want to review them beforehand. Please select to make your profile public.

Finally, your Google Scholar profile is complete!

You can edit your details anytime. It will appear in Google Scholar when someone searches for your name.
