#### **EVENT SUMMARY:**

On December 8th, 2023, the Equal Opportunity Cell of Sri Venkateswara College, in collaboration with AAROH and UMOVA, organized a Nukkad Natak titled "Know for Our Ability Not for Our Disability." The event aimed to raise awareness about the challenges faced by people with disabilities (PWDs) and encourage inclusivity, as a part of initiative by the Department of Social Welfare to celebrate Dis ability Awareness Week.

Volunteers and delegates from UMOVA and AAROH arrived at the college campus at 12:20 PM. Approximately 120 students attended the Nukkad Natak, which began with a welcome speech by, our convener Dr. Kanwar sir. Moving further Principal sir addressed the crowd, highlighting the challenges faced by PWDs and encouraging awareness towards them. Dr. Krishna Kumar also informed the audience about the facilities available in the college and emphasizing the importance of utilizing them properly. Following this, Mr. Rakesh sir, head of AAROH, addressed the crowd and set the event in motion.

Volunteers from AAROH and UMOVA spread awareness about various types of disabilities, government PWD acts, and the seven disabilities closed under them. The event then commenced with a beautiful dance performance by a first-year student volunteer. This was followed by the star attraction, the Nukkad Natak, which highlighted the issues, social injustice, and taboos faced by PWD individuals in daily life. The performance concluded with a powerful message: "Meri viklangta se badi meri kamyaabi hai" (My success is greater than my disability).

The event also featured a series of stunning performances by AAROH's students, including solo and group dances. The performances, which addressed disabilities, mental illness, crime against women, moved the audience. Additionally, volunteers from both organizations organized engaging games for PWDs, making the event both educational and enjoyable. The Nukkad Natak was a resounding success, raising awareness and fostering inclusivity within the college community
