



Event Title: Delhi Pollution Awareness

Date: 24th January 2024

Venue: ANS Senior Secondary School Auditorium

Objective:

The primary objective of the event was to raise awareness among students about the critical issue of pollution in Delhi, its causes, impacts, and the measures that can be taken to mitigate it.
