The event began with a detailed discussion on "Examining the Dynamics of Bilateral Relations Between India and Australia: A Focus on Key Areas of Cooperation and Challenges," conducted by Michael Rees, Second Secretary at the Australian High Commission. After the presentation, the attendees actively participated in a one-on-one Q&A session, discussing topics such as Electric Vehicles, Green Energy, AI, DPI, and Ministerial visits.

More than 60 individuals actively participated in the event, asking questions about Mr. Michael's experience as an Australian Diplomat in India and his Hindi language learning experience. This led to a valuable exchange of ideas, offering insights into the complex world of diplomacy and fostering a meaningful exchange of ideas between the distinguished guest and the engaged student community.

The session also delved into the nuanced aspects of the India-Australia bilateral relationship. Topics of discussion included collaborative initiatives, trade relations, strategic partnerships, cultural exchanges, and the challenges and opportunities within this diplomatic engagement. The session also touched upon the evolving regional landscape, emphasizing the significance of multilateral forums such as the Quadrilateral Security Dialogue (QUAD) and cooperation in the Indo-Pacific region.

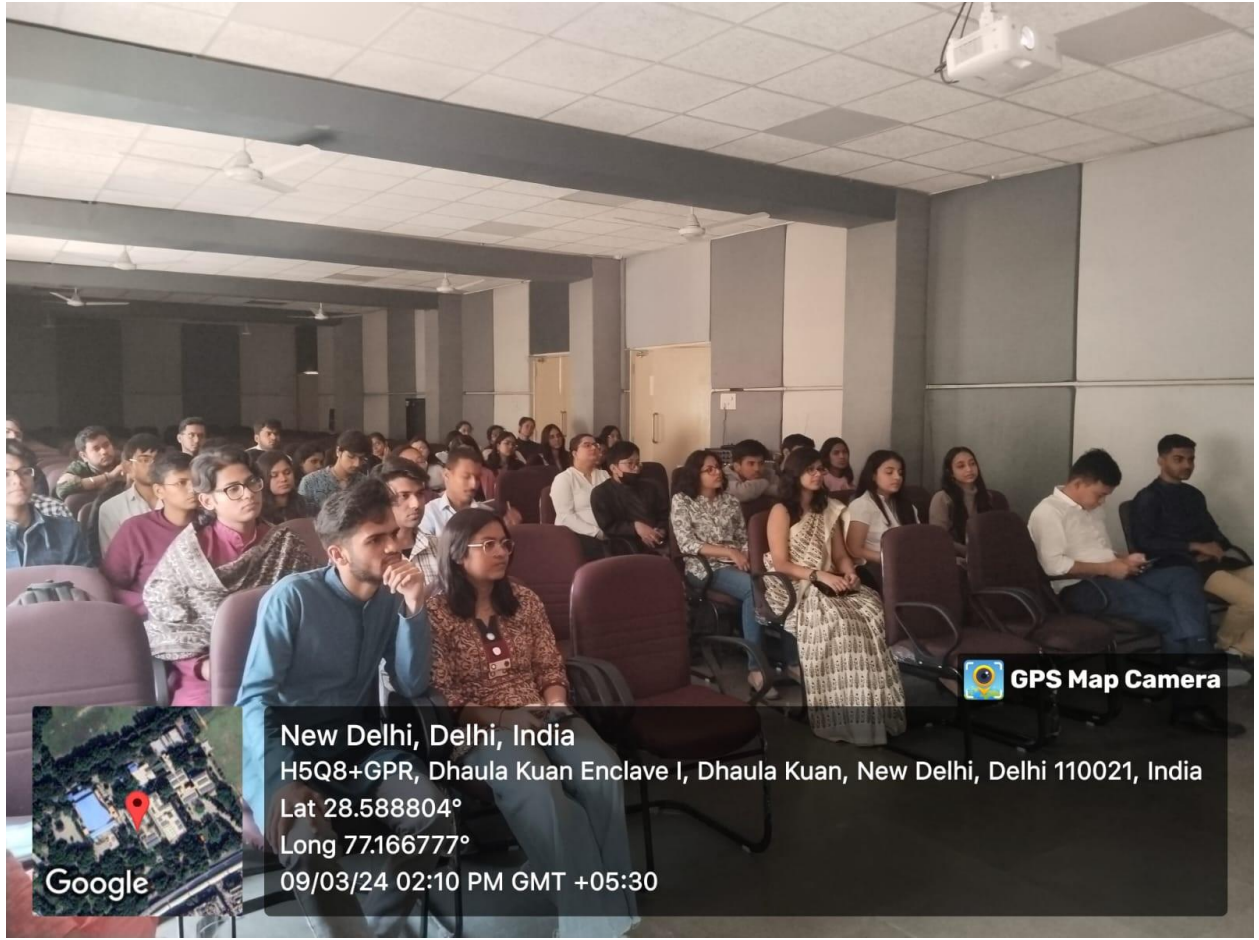
