
#### **EVENT REPORT**


The event began with a detailed discussion on "Examining the Dynamics of Bilateral Relations Between India and Australia: A Focus on Key Areas of Cooperation and Challenges," conducted by Michael Rees, Second Secretary at the Australian High Commission. After the presentation, the attendees actively participated in a one-on-one Q&A session, discussing topics such as Electric Vehicles, Green Energy, AI, DPI, and Ministerial visits.

More than 60 individuals actively participated in the event, asking questions about Mr. Michael's experience as an Australian Diplomat in India and his Hindi language learning experience.
