<b>METHODOLOGY</b>	<p>For this event, the methodology likely involved a two-pronged approach. Firstly, a <b>lecture</b> format was used to deliver comprehensive information about the fourth year of the UG programme under NEP 2020 to a larger audience. This aimed to provide a foundational understanding of the key changes and their implications. Secondly, a dedicated <b>help desk/booth</b> was set up to offer personalized support. Staffed by UGC's NEP Ambassadors, this interactive space allowed students to directly engage with experts, ask specific questions, and receive tailored guidance to address their individual queries and concerns related to the new policy.</p>

The **NEP 2020 Booth/Help Desk event**, a significant component of the Sri Venkateswara College (SVC) festivity on April 17th, 2025, was meticulously organized to guide students through the nuances of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, particularly concerning the introduction of the fourth year to the Undergraduate Programme. A dedicated lecture, held in the V. Krishnamurthy Block's Room No. 57 during the afternoon, served as a platform for a detailed exposition of the new academic framework. Here, students had the opportunity to gain a comprehensive understanding of the structural changes, curriculum modifications, and the overall rationale behind the fourth year addition.



Complementing the lecture, a readily accessible help desk operated throughout a larger part of the day. Situated within the bustling environment of the college fest, this booth was strategically manned by the UGC's own NEP Ambassadors assigned to SVC. These knowledgeable individuals were present to engage directly with students, providing a personalized avenue to address their individual questions, dispel any confusion, and alleviate concerns related to the implications of NEP 2020 on their academic journeys. This interactive setup fostered a comfortable space for open dialogue, allowing students to seek specific information relevant to their individual circumstances. Whatever queries that required further clarification were forwarded by the NEP Saarthi to the administration. The initiative, driven by the commitment of the NEP SAARTHI Committee, underscored the college's proactive stance in ensuring that its student body was well-informed and prepared for the evolving educational landscape, ultimately aiming for a seamless and positive transition into the restructured undergraduate programme.

## **UGC-NEP SAARTHI COMMITTEE, SVC [UoD]**

**NEP SAARTHI COMMITTEE ORGANIZED A HELPDESK/ BOOTH AND A LECTURE IN THE COLLEGE CAMPUS, WHERE SEVERAL QUERIES REGARDING NEP 2020 WERE CLARIFIED. CERTAIN UNANSWERED OR AMBIGUOUS QUESTIONS ARE BEING FORWARDED TO ADMINISTRATION BY NEP SAARTHI COMMITTEE OF SVC.**

### **QUERIES-**

1] If there is an ER in 5<sup>th</sup> semester can a student pursue 4<sup>TH</sup> YEAR i.e. 7<sup>th</sup> semester. As the minimum requirement for pursuing 4<sup>th</sup> year is PASS in 3<sup>rd</sup> year.

2] The general query from programme courses concern that they have subjects from different departments, if they plan to pursue 4<sup>th</sup> year the research burden on the parent departments will increase as these department also have their honours. Student. So how the human resource issue will be dealt with, especially in the 4<sup>th</sup> year.

3] The query concerns that a programme student when completes 4 year graduation gets a honours degree, whether in this case the 4<sup>th</sup> year will have research [dissertation] element. If yes, will it be reflected in the degree issued by the university.

4] Query is concerned with doc no. CNC-11/093/1/EC-1273/25/ dated 13.02.2025 [University of Delhi], What is the difference between level 6.5 [1 year PG after 4 year graduation] and level 7 [a 2 year PG post 4 year graduation].

Will this difference in levels create any difference in future between a candidate with level 6.5 and level 7 having post graduation degree done.

5] How are dissertations different from academic projects in 4<sup>th</sup> year. As 4<sup>th</sup> year is being organised in the college premises, will students get opportunity to explore and do research work with higher equipment offering in university labs. How many students will be assigned under a faculty member to conduct research.

6] Can a student opt for more GE's./ DSE's. in 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> semesters to ensure that they get a minor degree in a concerned discipline if in case student doesn't have required credits from GE's/ DSE's of previous semesters.

8] B.Com. honours. And prog. students study 3 DSC every semester and it's a single discipline course with no minor and major in B.Com. prog. Therefore on completing 4<sup>th</sup> year will both honours. and prog. students be given honours. with research degree? Also is the honours. degree of 3 years and 4 year programme turned honours. degree of equal value?

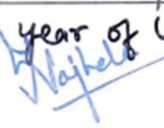
