6. **Completed Events-** The following activities were accomplished by NEP SAARTHI in the period from 8th Feb 2024 to 30th May 2024.

Event 1: NEP Quiz (12th Feb 2024)-

The official functioning of NEP SAARTHI Committee commenced with the inaugural event ‘NEP Quiz’ on 12th Feb 2024 at room no. 57, Dr. V. Krishnamoorthy block, Sri Venkateswara College, Dhaula Kuan, New Delhi. The first calendar-scheduled event

started with lighting of the lamp followed by Saraswati Vandana. Dr. Neelam Kumari, the coordinator of the NEP SAARTHI committee welcomed guests and students present in the event room and delivered an inaugural speech about National Education Policy-2020. She further introduced everyone out there with the NEP SAARTHI committee, its core objectives and significance. The then respected Principal Prof. K. Chandramani Singh was called on the dais to commence the event NEP Quiz.

The quiz was simply based on National Education Policy-2020 and the questions were framed to gauge the individuals' basic understanding, key features and highlights about NEP. There were two separate quizzes- one for students only and another quiz for teachers only. Thirty-one participants joined in the quiz for student's category whereas seventeen participants joined the quiz for teacher's category. The quiz winners were called on stage and rewarded with an individual trophy as well as an appreciation certificate. The volunteers were also handed the appreciation certificates. The NEP SAARTHIs Ms. Himangi Patnaik, Mr. Syed Sameed Anwar, Ms. Tarannum Chowdhary and student support Ms. Blessy Leimapokpam did a great team work together to make the event a success. Finally, the event concluded with the vote of thanks by Dr. Rangarajan T.M. and Mr. Anuj Kumar, NEP SAARTHI Co-coordinators.

Event 2: Media Bites for “Mera Pehla Vote Desh Ke Liye” Campaign (11th March 2024)-

Video bites were recorded featuring students from Sri Venkateswara College as part of the 'Mera Pehla Vote Desh Ke Liye' initiative. This effort was collaboratively executed by the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting in conjunction with the Press Information Bureau (PIB). The primary objectives of this initiative were to underline the significance of voting among college-going youth and those who have recently attained voting age. Additionally, videos recorded in regional languages such as Kuki, Bangla, and Odia were to emphasize the importance of regional linguistic diversity and to broaden the reach to a more extensive audience. Total six students participated in the said activity and that is what served the purpose well. The recording took place in the SVC campus itself majorly in foyer area and the ground pathway.

The recording work commenced with a brief media byte featuring former Ag. Principal Prof. (Dr.) K. Chandramani Singh emphasizing the significance of voting. Subsequently, short video clips of 30-40 seconds duration were captured, featuring

students from Sri Venkateswara College advocating the importance of voting under the banner of “Mera Pehla Vote Desh Ke Liye”. To further amplify the outreach, videos were also produced in regional languages including Kuki, Bangla, and Odia. Concluding the recording session, a collective video was filmed featuring 9-10 students collectively stating “Mera Pehla Vote Desh Ke Liye”.

Subsequently, these concise media bytes were shared across the official social media channels of the Ministry of Education, including X (Formerly Twitter) and Instagram. This dissemination facilitated broader engagement and outreach, effectively reaching a diverse and extensive audience.

Event 3: Student Lectures on NEP 2020 (18th March 2024)-

Conducting *Students Lecture on NEP-2020* was the second activity as per the activity calendar provided by the University Grants Commission (UGC) for the current year 2024. The students lecture event on NEP-2020 was highly informative and engaging that took place on 18th March 2024 at ICT lab. Hosted by the NEP SAARTHI Committee, the lecture aimed to shed light on the major reforms introduced in the education sector of our country through NEP 2020.

Our NEP SAARTHIs Ms. Himangi Patnaik, Mr. Syed Sameed Anwar and Ms. Tarannum Chowdhary shared their insights and perspectives on how the NEP 2020 will impact various aspects of the education system, including school education, higher education, vocational education, and teacher training. Mr. Syed Sameed Anwar, an NEP-SAARTHI described vision, mission, objectives and targets of NEP-2020. He began with an introduction to the NEP 2020, highlighting its significance in shaping the future of education in India. Ms. Tarannum Chowdhary, the other NEP-SAARTHI) gave lecture on Academic Bank of Credits followed by Himangi Patnaik, the third NEP SAARTHI explained 10 pillar themes of NEP-2020. There took place a detailed discussion on the key pillars of the policy, including holistic education, multidisciplinary approach, flexibility in curriculum, and emphasis on research and innovation.

Overall, the NEP 2020 lecture provided a comprehensive overview of the policy's objectives, strategies, and implementation plans. The aim of the policy has inspired and motivated students to contribute towards the transformation of the education sector in India. Event ended with the vote of thanks.

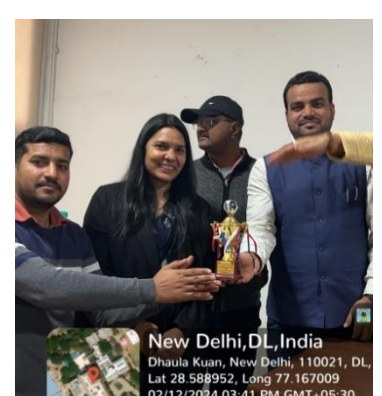
Event 4: Media Bites for "Mera Pehla Vote Desh Ke Liye" Campaign (22nd March 2024)-

Media segments were captured featuring students from Sri Venkateswara College as part of the 'Mera Pehla Vote Desh Ke Liye' initiative. This effort was collaboratively executed by IANS (Indo- Asian News Service) Media house team. The IANS team recorded bytes to engage discussions with students from Sri Venkateswara College, focusing on the significance of voting for first-time voters. Three teachers as well as fourteen students took part in this activity and allowed themselves to face camera roll for video bite recording in the common staffroom and foyer area. The activity aimed to emphasize the importance of voting, highlight awareness programs designed to alleviate the anxieties and confusion associated with being a first-time voter, and promote greater civic participation among college-going youth. The primary objective of these interactions was to raise awareness about the electoral process and inspire more young individuals to exercise their voting rights.

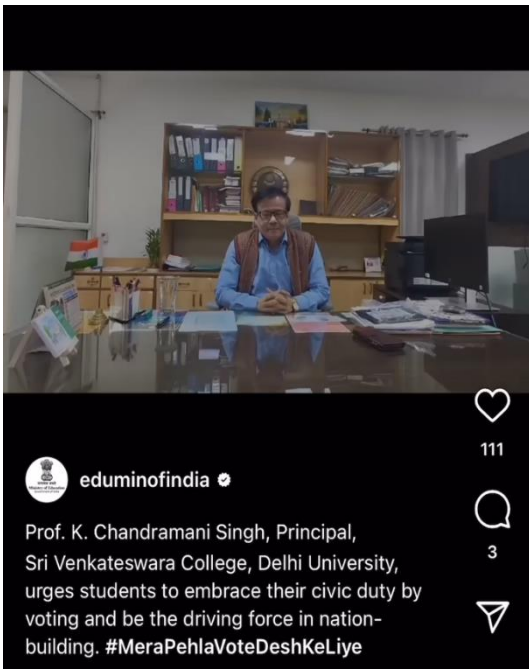

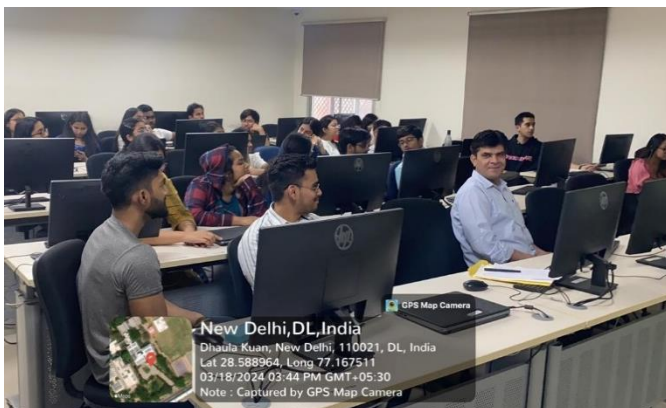
A. Pictures of Event 1: Quiz on NEP 2020


Acknowledgement / Closing Note-
