BRIEF INFORMATION ABOUT THE ACTIVITY

TOPIC/SUBJECT OF THE ACTIVITY	Condemning heinous acts of violence against women and demanding right for women to exist safely in workplace.
OBJECTIVES	 Raising Awareness: To bring attention to the prevalence and seriousness of violence against women in the society at large, highlighting the need for collective action. Advocating for Safety: To demand safe and respectful environments for women, both in educational settings and workplaces, free from harassment, discrimination, and violence. Promoting Gender Equality: To emphasize the importance of gender equality, advocating for equal rights, opportunities, and treatment for women in all aspects of life. Empowering Women: To empower women by providing them with a platform to express their experiences, concerns, and demands, fostering a sense of solidarity and support and promoting a culture of respect and safety. Challenging Cultural Norms: To challenge and change harmful cultural norms and attitudes that perpetuate violence against women, promoting a culture of respect and equality. Educating the Community: To educate the campus community and the broader public about the impacts of violence against women and the importance of safe and inclusive workplaces.

	7. Inspiring Further Action: To inspire ongoing efforts and initiatives aimed at preventing violence against women and advocating for gender equality, both on and off campus.
METHODOLOGY	The march was held through various significant points around the campus that see the maximum footfall. Students walked with hand-painted posters that displayed slogans with the above objectives in mind. Since it was a silent march, sloganeering was not done.
INVITED SPEAKERS WITH AFFLIATION DETAILS (IF ANY)	The floor was open to all. Few of the faculty and some students spoke their minds.
OUTCOMES	 The march brought attention to the pertinent issues making it a topic of discussion among students, faculty, and the broader community. It created a sense of solidarity, showing that there is a collective demand for change and a shared commitment to gender equality and safety. It managed to educate participants and observers about the prevalence and seriousness of violence against women, leading to a more informed and sensitive campus culture. The march inspired additional initiatives which would be carried out in future, such as workshops, seminars, or campaigns, aimed at preventing violence and promoting gender equality on campus and beyond. Overall, the march was a powerful and peaceful way to demand justice and create momentum for lasting change.



Brief Report:

On 21st August 2024, the Women Development Cell of Sri Venkateshwara College organized a silent march to protest against the recent horrific rape case that occurred in R.G Kar Medical College in Kolkata, India and the systemic issue of sexual violence against women. The preparations for the march began early in the morning, with volunteers and members of the cell diligently working on posters, creating impactful messages to raise awareness about the issue of sexual violence. The march commenced at 12:00 pm from the college foyer, where the Vice Principal delivered a powerful speech, emphasizing the importance of standing together against such atrocities and teaching men to be better people. The procession moved solemnly through the campus, passing by the Maggie Point, the Badminton Court, Canteen Lawns, and the Rock Garden, before circling back to the foyer. The atmosphere was charged with a sense of unity and purpose as many students from various departments joined the march as it proceeded, displaying their solidarity against the heinous acts of rape, victim blaming, unjust criminal justice system etc. The event concluded at around 12:30 PM, with the president of the society addressing the gathering followed by professors who talked about nuances of sexual assault against women, trans-people, tribal people and other minorities. The silent march served as a poignant reminder of the collective voice of the youth against violence and the urgent need for justice and safety for all.
