REPORT

Youth India Foundation, Sri Venkateswara College, successfully organized an offline workshop titled **“From Prototype to Production: Mastering AI Workflows”** on **18th April 2026**, aimed at equipping participants with practical knowledge of building and scaling AI applications. The session focused on guiding attendees through the complete AI development lifecycle using tools such as Google AI Studio, Gemini, and Vertex AI. Key areas covered included prompt engineering and iterative refinement, multimodal prototyping using text, code, images, and video, code export and integration into local environments, and scaling solutions through Vertex AI for deployment and monitoring. Through live demonstrations and hands-on exercises, participants gained exposure to industry-relevant workflows and best practices for designing, testing, and deploying production-ready AI systems. The workshop emphasized practical implementation, scalability, and real-world application, enabling participants to strengthen their technical skills and understanding of modern AI development processes.

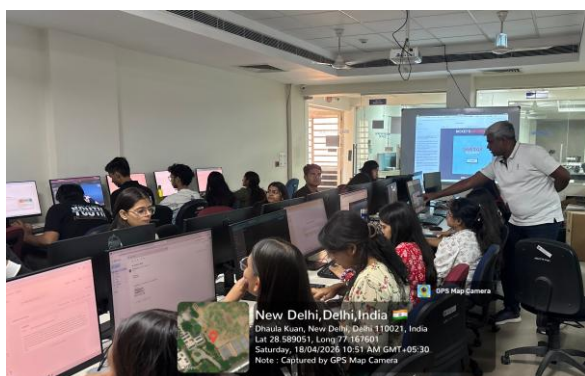

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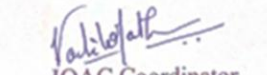
