# POINTS TO REMEMBER

- Mapping the correct CUET Paper to Class XII subjects will be an essential component. However, there will be no requirement of mapping the General test.
- Upon correct mapping, only the Programs in which a candidate is eligible will be visible on the dashboard of the candidate. This means the dashboard of every candidate has been customized to for him/her to select only the Program + College combinations in which s(he) is eligible, therefore, its important to map your subjects with utmost care

# STEP-4: COURSE- COLLEGE PREFERENCE SELECTION

The candidates can see all the combinations of course and college they can apply for in the “available preferences” section

1. For B.A.(Prog) combinations, where Mathematics/Statistics/Computer Applications/ Computer Science is one of the two core disciplines, It is mandatory that the candidate must have studied and passed Mathematics in class XII examinations. Similarly, wherever a language is being offered as one of the two disciplines, the candidates must have a working knowledge of that language.
2. Use the filter above to narrow down the preferences displayed in the Available Preferences section.
3. Select preferences from the Available Preferences list and add them to your Selected Preferences.
4. Save your changes regularly using the 'Save Changes' button to prevent data loss, and always save before proceeding to Preview Preference Selection.

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

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
# WORKING OF THE PREFERENCE SECTION

# POINTS TO REMEMBER

- Fill according to your true preference order (fill out the college-program combination you want the most as 1, your second choice on 2 and so on)
- Don't Fear your low score (don't leave out top colleges even if you think your CUET score is low)
- Fill as much combinations as possible, the more college-course combinations you fill, the better is the chances for you to get a seat
- Course>College: Prioritize your desired degree and academic future over physical campus
- Review Carefully: Double-check every preference before you save (remember to click on the save preferences option every once in a while so that the list is not deleted if the page refreshes by chance).
- Do Not Rush: Take your time to research colleges and courses before submitting. Preparation and logical decision making will guide you through.
