FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQs)

Q1. What should I carry on the first day of college?

Ans: Carry your admission slip for entry, ID proof, a notebook, pen, water bottle, etc. Don't forget to bring enthusiasm and curiosity.

Q2. When is the First day of College?

Ans: You have to report to your college on 1st August 2025.

Q3. At what time should I report on the first day?

Ans. Report at 9 am on the first day.

Q4. Where do I report on the first day?

Ans: After seeking the blessings of Lord Venkateswara at the temple inside the College (after entering from Gate No. 1, proceed to your respective department by following the signboards displayed in the college. You will also receive instructions from the Teacher-in-Charge regarding the venue of the Departmental Orientation Program.

Q5. What is the schedule for the first week?

Ans: The first few days are usually for orientation, introduction to faculty, different courses orientations, and society showcases. Regular classes begin as per the timetable issued by your department.

Q6. When will our College Orientation Program?

Ans. The College Orientation Program will be held on 5th August 2025 at 10.30 AM in the College Ground.

Q7. From which gate are students allowed to enter the College?

Ans 7 The college has three gates: Gate No. 1 (Main Gate), Gate No. 2 (Staff Quarters Side Gate), and the Ring Road Side Gate. Students can enter through Gate No. 1 or the Ring Road Side Gate after showing their admission slip and ID proof.

Q8. Is there any dress code for the College?

Ans. No, there is no specific dress code for the College. You can wear any comfortable and decent dress. Also, for Chemistry Practical labs, properly covered clothes are preferred to avoid any direct contact of the skin with chemicals.

Q9. When will we receive our class timetable?

Ans: The department teacher-in-charge will share the timetable either during department orientation or via email/WhatsApp groups on the first day.

Q10. How many lectures are there per day?

Ans: Typically, there are 4-6 lectures per day along with practicals or tutorials, depending on your course. Each lecture lasts about 1 hour.

Q11. Are there practicals or tutorials as well?

Ans: Yes, depending on your program, you will have practical and/or tutorial sessions along with lectures.

Q12. What is the Orientation Program? Is attendance compulsory?

Ans: Yes, it is compulsory. It is an introductory event where you will meet the Principal, faculty members, and get an overview of college facilities, rules, and student societies. You must attend it.

Q13. Will there be a separate department orientation?

Ans: Yes, in addition to the main orientation, individual departments conduct their own orientation session where you will meet your teachers and classmates.

Q14. Who is the Teacher-in-Charge (TIC)?

Ans: The Teacher-in-Charge (TIC) is the faculty member responsible for overseeing the academic and administrative matters of your department. Their name will be shared during the departmental orientation. The list of TICs for all departments is also provided in the college prospectus as well as on the respective department pages of the college website.

Q15. How can I contact my teachers?

Ans: You'll be introduced to your teachers during orientation. You can contact them via college email or in person during office hours.

Q16. Where is the canteen? What kind of food is available?

Ans: The canteen is located behind the Science block. It serves snacks, beverages, and lunch at affordable prices.

Q 17. What is the way to our Department?

Ans. There are three buildings in the college, named the Arts Block, Science Block, and Durgabai Deshmukh Block. You can follow the signboards to locate your department's staff room and contact your Teacher-in-Charge (TIC) and faculty members.

Q18. Where is the Library? How do I use the library?

Ans: The library is located on the ground floor. You will be issued a library card or granted access through your student ID. A library orientation session is usually conducted during the first week.

Q19. Is there hostel accommodation available?

Ans: Yes, the college has separate hostels for boys and girls. You need to apply separately, and seats are allotted based on merit and availability.

Q20. Are there any PGs near the college?

Ans: Yes, there are many Paying Guest (PG) accommodations available around the college area, such as in Satyaniketan (Opposite the College). You can ask seniors for recommendations or check online platforms like NoBroker, 99acres, or local notice boards for options.

Q21. Is there a bank or ATM on campus?

Ans: Yes, our college has a branch of the Union Bank of India and an ATM facility on campus.

Q22. Are sports facilities available?

Ans: Yes, our college has sports grounds, a basketball court, a badminton court, a cricket ground, and more. You can register for games like cricket, basketball, badminton, and table tennis during the sports orientation program.

Q23. What are common rooms? Where are these located?

Ans: These are designated rooms for boys and girls to relax, socialize, or study during breaks. Some are equipped with newspapers, recreational items, and seating.

Q24. Who are the office/admin staff, and where is the college office?

Ans: The college office is on the right side of the foyer near the main entrance. Admin staff assist with queries related to admission, fees, documents, scholarships, etc.

Q25. Will there be a student helpdesk in the College on the first day?

Ans. Yes, to assist freshers, a students' helpdesk will be set up in the foyer.

Q26. How can I join college societies or clubs?

Ans: During the first week, most societies organize orientation sessions, auditions, or registrations. You can participate as per your interest (drama, debate, music, dance, etc.).

Q27. Is it compulsory to join a society?

Ans: No, but it is recommended to join at least one society to build skills, network, and enhance your college experience.

Q28. Whom should I contact for any personal or academic issues?

A: You can speak with your mentor teacher, Teacher-in-Charge, or the student counselor.

Q29. Are there any WhatsApp or Telegram groups for freshers?

A: Yes, departments and societies create official groups to share updates. These are usually formed by faculty or class reps.

Q30. Can parents accompany students to the Departmental Orientation Program? Ans: No, the Departmental Orientation on the first day is only for students. Parents are invited to the College Orientation Program scheduled for 5th August 2025 at 10:30 AM.
