



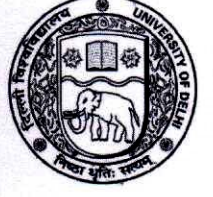

**సూచనా / NOTICE**

**Regarding Selection of GE and GEL Options**

**ONLY FOR SEMESTER I**

All the Undergraduate Students are directed to fill the GE and GEL Options for Semester I on or before 17 August 2025 by logging onto the ERP Portal.

Students in Semester I can opt for one GE or GEL Paper.

**Note:**

1. Check the eligibility/pre-requisites for the courses and apply only if you are eligible/fulfil prerequisites for the course.
2. The students must go through the detailed instructions given below before filling in the option form.
3. It is mandatory for all the students to fill out the GE and GE(L) options on ERP Portal.

**For All Courses**

- **Students pursuing Hons. Courses:** Students cannot opt for a GE offered by the parent department. For example, a student pursuing B.A. (Hons) Hindi can opt for GE of any department excluding the Department of Hindi.





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- 7 GE's of a particular department qualify a student for a minor in that subject, provided they have a major degree.
- Major is only possible after Semester VIII.
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**For B.A. (Prog)**

- The discipline of GE must be different from the Core Discipline.
- All B.A. (Prog) Students can choose any one GE paper from a pool of languages (English, Hindi, Sanskrit, Tamil, Telugu).
- All B.A.(Prog) Students have to study two GE Languages (GEL); One in Semesters I and III, and the other in Semesters II and IV. At least one of the languages should be an Indian Language.
- Note that the GE Languages should be different from both core disciplines.
- All B.A. (Prog) Students with two languages as core disciplines can choose GE from the open pool (and not restricted to choosing only the GE Languages).
- All B.A. (Prog) Students with one language as a core discipline can choose only one GE Language (which will be the same courses of the same language that may be studied in Semesters I and III or Semesters II and IV). The other two GE's shall be from the open pool of GE's.
- Semester I students of SVC to choose English as GE Language (GEL), and wait for the other GE Language (GEL) in the next semester.
- If English is their core discipline, then they can choose any other MIL (Sanskrit, Tamil, and Telugu) from the GEL Pool or choose GE from the open pool.
- The language in Semester III should be different from the language chosen in Semester II.
- The language in Semester III should be the same as the language chosen in Semester I.
- B.A.(Prog) Students who have never studied any Modern Indian Language (MIL) up to Class VIII can choose from the open pool of GE's.

**For B.Com. (Prog)**

- The discipline of GE must be different from the Core Discipline.
- All B.Com. (Prog) Students can choose any one GE paper from a pool of languages (English, Hindi, Sanskrit, Tamil, Telugu).
- All B.Com (Prog) Students have to study two GE Languages (GEL); One is Semesters I and III, and the other is Semesters II and IV. At least one of the languages should be an Indian Language.
- Semester I students of SVC to choose Hindi as GE Language (GEL), and wait for the other GE language (GEL) in the next semester.
- Students opting for Hindi as GE must note the following:
  - Hindi A -for students who studied Hindi up to class XII.
  - Hindi B- for students who studied Hindi up to class X.
  - Hindi C- for students who have studied Hindi up to class VIII
- The language in Semester III should be different from the language chosen in Semester II.
- The language in Semester III should be the same as the language chosen in Semester I.
- B.Com (Prog) Students who have never studied any Modern Indian Language (MIL) up to Class VIII can choose from the open pool of GE's.





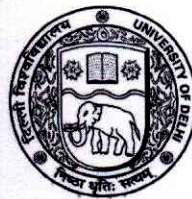
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**For Life Science**

- They can take GE from departments other than Botany, Chemistry, and Zoology.
- The students can get a minor only in Botany/Chemistry/Zoology.
- The concept of major and minor comes only if the students pursue FOUR Years (EIGHT Semesters) of the UG course.
- Students cannot get a minor in non-core subjects, since they need to do 9 DSEs for a major. This leaves the option for 5 GEs. So, the 28 credit points cannot be accumulated for a minor in non-core papers.

**For Bioscience**

- They can opt for any GE from the GE Pool.
