A. General Introduction

WHEREAS Sri Venkateswara College (hereinafter referred to as said "College") is a constituent college of University of Delhi and is managed by Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanams Trust, Tirupati (hereinafter called the "Trust") through its Governing Body constituted under the provision of Delhi University Act and Rules, Regulations framed under the said Act; AND

WHEREAS College was given on lease on or about 05 Acres of land for promoting sports; AND

WHEREAS out of the above-mentioned land, College has earmarked an area measuring on or about 100 mtrs x 90 mtrs approx. (hereinafter referred as "Said Area") herewith for Cricket game; AND

WHEREAS the College already has Cricket Ground and practice pitches in the Said Area and well maintained at the time of uploading this document; AND

WHEREAS, amongst others, College is interested in promotion of Cricket game besides others amongst its students and has named its said activity as a Cricket Academy (hereinafter referred to as "Cricket Academy"); AND

WHEREAS, the Selected bidder will be provided with the Cricket Ground and Practice Pitches only on "as is where is basis". All other facilities as required for successful operations and maintenance of the Cricket Academy shall be arranged by the selected bidder at his/her own cost including the provision of repair/replacement & maintenance of Ground, Store Room, Housekeeping and Security of the tendered premises.

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WHEREAS, an energy meter/ sub-meter will be installed for the tendered space by College and the selected Bidder shall pay the amount of monthly electricity bill (Per unit @commercial rates+PPA+taxes+any other charges as per existing BSES rates) to the College, pertaining to the said area, as indicated by the installed sub-meter by 7th day of subsequent months with intimation to the In-charge of the academy by email. This shall be in addition to the Licence fee. In case of failure to deposit the bill within stipulated time surcharge will be levied at applicable rates.

In addition, consolidated amount of Rs 5000/- per month towards water charges will be applicable which is to be paid by selected bidder.

The College is interested that competent experienced person, who has played Cricket game or has experience of coaching in promoting Cricket game and is capable of managing and running of Cricket Academy, is entrusted with the managing and running of the Cricket Academy.

The College may require the facilities during the tenure of the agreement (for approximately 20-25 days or more per year), for organizing any event or for any other purposes and selected bidder shall provide the same upon request of the College. The College will normally give 15 days' notice to the successful bidder but the said period of notice is not mandatory and the same may be reduced depending upon exigencies of the College. In case the facilities are required by the college for a longer duration than the above-mentioned period, the successful bidder shall provide the same without seeking any kind of compensation.

B. Conditions of Eligibility:

- a. The cricket club or institution must be duly affiliated with the Delhi and District Cricket Association (DDCA) and must have been in continuous operation for not less than 5 years in coaching, maintaining and running cricket academy. Necessary documents are to be attached; AND

- b. In case the Bidder is Corporate Entity/Society/Partnership Firm, one of its working Director/Office bearers of the Society/Working Partner/Hired Head Coach, should have been Dronacharya awardee/NCA or BCCI certified level 3 coach/played in the minimum of 10 matches at the Ranji Trophy/Duleep Trophy/Deodhar Trophy level and demonstrated expertise in player development; AND
- c. The assistant coach should be NCA/BCCI certified level 2 or level 1 coach/played at Ranji level/state level; AND
- d. That the institution/society/partnership firm must have produced players who have played/represented the sport at least at the International/National/Ranji level reflecting its sustained contribution to player promotion and excellence in performance in the past or in the current session.
- e. It is desirable to have a Physiotherapist Strength and Conditioning Coach.
- f. The audited total annual turnover of the bidder shall be minimum of 30 lakhs for the last three financial years.
- C. Keeping in view the aforesaid fact, the College therefore, has decided to invite bids from the eligible parties.
1. Online Bids are invited in forward auction on GeM, to manage Cricket Academy, which is proposed to be run at Sri Venkateswara College on said Area, which is a part of College Sports Grounds.

The successful bidder himself as well as by engaging other qualified Coach(es) as mentioned above shall impart coaching to the students of the College and others in the game of Cricket. **Manual Bids shall not be accepted.**
 2. The complete tender papers duly accompanied with requisite EMD shall be uploaded as per date and time mentioned in the bid.

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3. **Bid Submission/PQ submission:**

The bid shall be submitted online only at GeM portal [http:// gem.gov.in](http://gem.gov.in).

Tenderer/ Contractor is advised to follow "Instructions to Bidder for Online Bid Submission" provided in the Annexures for online submissions of Bids.

Bid document may be scanned with 100 dpi with black and white option which helps in reducing size of the scanned document.

4. Not more than one tender shall be submitted by one bidder or bidders having business relationship. Under no circumstances will father and his son(s) or other close relations who have business relationship with one another (i.e. when one or more partner(s)/ director(s) are common) be allowed to tender for the same contract as a separate competitor. A breach of this condition will render the tenders of both parties liable to rejection.

Not more than one tender shall be submitted by any licensee/ trusts/ any firm or societies/having kinship relationships.

5. Tenderer who has downloaded the tender from GeM portal shall not tamper/modify the tender form including downloaded financial Bid template in any manner. In case if the same is found to be tampered/ modified in any manner, tender will be completely rejected and EMD would be forfeited and tenderer is liable to be banned from doing business with Sri Venkateswara College.

6. Intending tenderers are advised to visit GeM Portal from time to time, till closing date of submission of **tender for any corrigendum / addendum amendment.**

7. The College has its Account being A/c No. 136210011005005, IFSC Code UBIN0813621 in Union Bank of India, South Campus Branch, New Delhi (hereinafter called the "Account of College") for remitting.

EMD Payment:

Earnest Money Deposit as per the GeM rules is to be deposited through e-payment in favour of **Account of College**. Bidders are required to submit the details of EMD (bearing no interest) payment at the time of Bid submission.

8. A copy of original relevant documents in respect of Earnest Money Deposit, audited Balance Sheet and Income Tax return for last three years shall be uploaded on GeM as per PQ documents requested in the bid and ATC.

Opening of Bids

9. Bid opening details shall be uploaded online as per the GeM rules from time to time. The vendors need to check their GeM portal on regular basis.

The bidder shall be allowed to participate in Forward Auction process only if qualified in PQ validation (technical evaluation). If required, the college may go for site inspection to verify the authenticity of technical bid documents. The financial bids, referred to above, will be opened and examined.

The bid of the successful bidder shall be the consideration of performance of the contract for one term for a period of **two years** from the date of the agreement. College may at its sole discretion, extend the contract for a further period (**two years + two years and further**) and the license fee for such extended period shall be enhanced viz. 20% of the license fee of the immediate earlier term. At any point of time, either party can terminate this contract/agreement by giving 2 months advance notice.

The period of contract may be extended for another four years in two phases of duration two years each and further, subject to the satisfactory performance report from the college competent authority.

The successful bidder has inspected and satisfied: -

- a. The College already has a well-maintained Cricket Ground and practice Pitches viz. one Ground and 4 Pitches (2 turf and 2 cemented mat).

The successful bidder, through their own staff, will be responsible for maintaining the said Ground and Pitches and maintaining said area and the same needs to be clean.

- b. The successful bidder will engage additional coaches, keeping in view of the requirement of the said coaches. He assures that every such coach would be duly qualified and competent coach as per bid terms and eligibility conditions mentioned above.

The successful bidder shall be permitted to construct a temporary structure like storage container/porta cabins from their own funds, for use as office/store room near the Cricket Ground and Pitches which is also a part of the said area without any interference. The structure cannot exceed an area of (3mtr x 6mtr = 18sq. mtrs) and the same should strictly be a temporary one with the approval of competent authority of college.

- c. The successful bidder, coaches and students shall be granted permission to use the bathroom near the sports ground only.
- d. Neither the successful bidder nor any of its employees, students, and visitors shall have any right to use any other portion of the College property/premises.
- e. All expenses of coaching, managing and running of the said Cricket Academy shall be borne and paid by the successful bidder.
- f. The successful bidder, from their own funds, shall regularly carry out maintenance, repairs of the Cricket Ground and Pitches and the said area, upkeep the facility (including **boundary wedge, Scoreboard, upgraded sight screens, dugouts/pavilion**, etc and any other such infrastructure development towards the said sport) as per standards. The plan of the

proposed upgrading shall be submitting by the bidder to the College along with date of the commencement and due of completion of every such upgrading activity.

g. All appointments and contracts, if any, shall be made and executed by successful bidder in the name of his organisation. The successful bidder shall have no right to enter into any contract for and on behalf of the College.

10. The successful bidder assures and undertakes: -

a. That he/she has been a regular Cricket player or is a qualified coach and is competent to coach students of the game as well as to manage and run Cricket Academy in the college including maintenance of Cricket Ground and Pitches & associated surrounding areas and infrastructure.

b. In case, the successful bidder of the view that the any of the existing Ground and Pitches needs to restructured/ re-laid and/or demolition, he shall submit the necessary proposal to the College, and on receipt of the approval from the college, he can restructure/ re-laid and/or demolition the said Ground and Pitches at his own expenses and the usable material such as steel of such Ground and Pitches shall be returned by him to the College. At the end of the contract period, the successful bidder shall handover, the properly maintained Cricket Ground and Pitches in the said area to the College. Also, any form of additional structures/equipments/infrastructure shall solely remain the property of the College and the bidder shall not claim any financial compensation for it.

c. That keeping in view the number of players enrolled, the successful bidder shall engage requisite number of Coaches. While deciding such requirement of Coaches, the level and rigour of coaching required by the players of the Academy may be taken into consideration. While

engaging coaches, engagement of female coaches shall also be considered.

- d. The Successful Bidder shall have no authority to engage any employee, coach, or personnel, nor to enter into any contract, on behalf of the College
- e. For carrying out the abovementioned activities, the successful bidder may engage employees including Coach(es) but the employees/coaches so engaged by the them will have no privity of contract with the College.

The successful bidder will further ensure that the salary and other statutory benefits, such as provident fund and other benefits which may be admissible to them, shall be paid by him viz., the successful bidder and the College will have no responsibility whatsoever.

In case the College is exposed to any such liability, successful bidder shall be liable to compensate the College for the costs and expenses incurred by the College and interest thereupon.

- f. Before engaging any coach and any other employee, the successful bidder shall get the necessary antecedents of the applicant, coach/employee and get the necessary verifications and ensure that the applicant has the necessary qualifications, experience and/or had never been involved and named as accused in any criminal case. The necessary bio-data and other details of the persons to be engaged along with the verification report shall be sent to the College.
- g. That the successful bidder shall be responsible for securing the college property including the said area. They shall also ensure no person including students, employees, visitors of the cricket academy etc. use any part of the college property barring the said area. They shall ensure that no nuisance is created in the college property including the said area and/or any commission of any unlawful and undesirable activities

including smoking, consuming alcohol etc. Consumption of non-vegetarian food is not permitted in the college premises.

- h. For carrying out the said obligations, the successful bidder *inter alia* may engage coach(es), security staff or avail services of any security agency for providing the necessary security arrangements, at their own expenses.

In the hiring of security staff and/or entering into any security arrangements with any security agency, the successful bidder shall ensure that keeping in view the number of the females students engaged with the Academy and/or female visitors, who come to visit the matches, the requisite number of female security guards/ security staff be engaged. Deployment of female security staff shall also be required at the washroom area and passage leading to the female washroom.

All the security arrangements shall be made by the successful bidder at his own expenses and that College shall have no privity of contract with any such security staff engaged by the Coach and/or with any security arrangement arrived at between the Coach and the Security Agency.

- i. The successful bidder shall comply with the Statutory Provisions, Rules and Regulations, orders which are applicable, including Contract Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Act, 1970; Employees State Insurance Act, Workman's Compensation Act, 1923, Payment of Wages Act, 1936, Employees Provident Fund (and Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 1952, Payment of Bonus Act, 1965 and The Minimum Wages Act, 1948. In case of any breach of any Act, Rules, Regulations, Orders, the successful bidder shall be responsible for the same. In case any proceedings are initiated against the College and/or any of its officials, the successful bidder shall be responsible for defending the College/ College officials and shall bear and pay all expenses incurred by the College/ College officials concerned.

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- j. That the successful bidder shall have no right or interest in the Said Area including Ground and Pitches and that the successful bidder agrees and accepts this agreement does not amount to letting out the Said Area and/or Ground and Pitches by the College to him and successful bidder has no right/ interest in the Ground and Pitches. He agrees and admits that he merely has a right to use the Said Area without creation of any right in him.
11. The successful bidder shall pay as Licence Fee / management charges detailed below: -
- a. The base price proposed for the bid shall be **Rs. 16 lakhs inclusive of GST per annum**. The said licence fee (as awarded in the bid by HI) be paid quarterly and the same shall be payable in advance to the College on or before 7th day of first calendar month of every quarter. In case of delay, the successful bidder shall be liable to pay interest @ 18% p.a. on the said amount.
- b. The College may require Cricket Ground and Pitches or any of the Ground and Pitches at any time and naturally the successful bidder shall have no access to the said Ground and Pitches during the said period of usage by the College. One well maintained practicing turf pitch shall be made always available to the college for their students/staff. As far as possible, the College shall give an advance notice of 15 days to the successful bidder except in case of emergency. In such cases the successful bidder shall provide the same without seeking any kind of compensation from the College.
- c. The successful bidder shall be liable to make the payment of the said electric energy recorded in the sub-meter besides other taxes, levies, charges etc. (Per unit @commercial rates+PPA+taxes+any other charges as per existing BSES rates) to the College. This shall be in addition to the Licence fee. In case of failure to deposit the bill within stipulated time, surcharge will be levied at applicable rates.

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- d. In addition, a consolidated amount of **Rs 5000/- per month** towards water charges will be applicable which is to be paid by selected bidder.
- e. Besides, the electricity and water charges the successful bidder shall also be liable to pay for any other taxes, levies, sur-charges or any other charges as may be levied by the authorities.

The successful bidder shall make the payment to the College within the time mentioned in the bill raised by the College on the bidder in respect of water and electricity consumed. In case, the bidder fails to make the payment on or before the date of payment prescribed by the College, the bidder shall become further liable to make payment as mentioned in the bill so raised and within the extended period so mentioned in the said bills. The bidder shall further be liable to make payment of interest on such delayed payment.


If however, the successful bidder fails to pay and/or neglects to pay payment within the said extended period as mentioned in the bill, the electricity and/or water supply, as concern, shall be withheld by the College.

- f. On the failure of any such payment on or before the 30 days, College will be entitled to terminate the Agreement. On such termination of Agreement, the successful bidder shall cease to have any permission to enter in the Said Area and/or any other part of the College Campus.
- g. The successful bidder shall be entitled to charge fees/ charges from the students enrolled with the Cricket Academy except those who are regular students of the College. Successful bidder shall give at least **50% of discount** in fee to the College Students for attending coaching/practicing sessions during the contract period. Licensee shall give **free of cost** coaching to the college cricket teams (Men and Women).

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Further, successful bidder shall give at least **50% of discount** in fee to College Staff and their family members or as fixed by the college.

- h. The scale of fees, charges etc of the college students as mentioned above shall be required to be submitted to the College and will be required to be approved by Principal of the College.
 - i. That successful bidder will not be entitled to use the Ground and Pitches and/or any other portion of the Said Area, for any purpose other than coaching, practicing Cricket, conducting of friendly matches between students/staff of the College(s) and/or member(s) of the Academy or with the other teams to give good practice to the students of the College. Further, such matches/tournaments shall be organised after seeking necessary approval from college. The bidder must use the ground for **academic purposes only**. The bidder is explicitly prohibited from generating revenue by organising tournaments or conducting any other **commercial activities** from the ground other than for coaching.
 - j. The successful bidder shall not advertise about usage of the College Ground and Pitches by it.
 - k. The successful bidder shall maintain the necessary records, including financial records, which shall be open to inspection of the College and shall be liable to provide true, certified and audited copies of such records as may be required by the College.
12. **Penalty:** In case of non-compliance of any terms & conditions of the agreement, the College reserves the right to impose penalty, forfeit the EMD or Performance Security Amount and terminate the contract with immediate effect.
13. The quoted amount must be inclusive of GST and all other maintenance charges by whatever name mentioned in tender documents.

14. In case of tie between two or more bids, decision of the competent authority of the college will be final on recommendations of committee after recording reasons in writing thereof.
15. The College reserves the right to cancel the tender at any stage without assigning any reason thereof.
16. However, the successful Vendor shall not be held responsible for events beyond their control (accidental and any other nature's constraints beyond control), which shall be established fairly, mutually, by due process. In the eventuality of such an occurrence, the successful Vendor shall discuss the way forward with the college authorities in a mutually understanding manner.

OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR "License for Sports Ground (for upkeep and maintenance of Sri Venkateswara College Sports Ground)"

- i. Successful bidder shall not claim any tenancy and/or any other right in College property (including the said area) under any circumstances.
- ii. Successful bidder shall not use the facility for any other purpose event whatsoever besides what has been agreed upon and shall not claim any right/title/interest therein.
- iii. Successful bidder shall not enter into any collaboration agreement and/or any other arrangement with regard to managing/running of the Cricket Academy and/or any of the matter(s), which forms part of the Tender/Agreement.
- iv. Successful bidder shall have adequate Ground staff including attendants, security staff etc for well maintaining Ground, practice pitches etc.
- v. Successful bidder will have to provide all necessary ground maintenance equipment such as grass cutting machine, rollers, hygiene products, brooms,

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other practice equipment as required for the said game etc. whatever name called.

vi. Successful bidder will directly pay all bills (as mentioned in the tender document) with respect to electricity/water/fuel consumed for in the operation and maintenance of the ground and submit the proof of the payment done in this regard to the college office.

vii. Successful bidder shall not do anything in the ground and/or any other part of the College property, which in the opinion of the college may be considered a nuisance and/or illegal.

viii. Successful bidder shall not transfer his rights/obligations, or change the membership & responsibilities of its office bearers, without intimation and prior approval of the Principal of the College.

ix. Successful bidder shall take maintenance satisfactory report from the competent authority of the college on the last day of every quarter without which it shall not be allowed to use the facility during the next quarter.

x. The successful bidder shall take all necessary precautions to ensure that no damage is caused to the college property during practice sessions or matches. In the event of any such damage, the bidder shall be liable to compensate the college as per the charges assessed and determined by the college authorities.

xi. **Performance Security:** Within 15 days of dispatch of the letter of acceptance from the buyer, the successful bidder shall furnish a performance security for an amount equivalent to 25% of the contract value i.e., **25% of the annual license fee** to Sri Venkateswara College, as per the contract. The said amount shall be deposited in Account of College referred to above, under intimation to the Principal and the same amount shall be refunded without any interest on the conclusion of the agreement.

xii. The Principal of the College and/or his nominee and/or College management (Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanams) can inspect the sports ground during

It is hereby made clear that the sports ground shall remain under the control and use of the college during the weekends and on public holidays. In the event that the successful bidder requires the use of the ground on weekends or on public holidays, the same may be availed only upon prior booking with the college and in accordance with the applicable charges.

xviii. Further, the successful bidder shall not prohibit the members (college staff and college students only) from playing on the Cricket Ground and Pitches during the college hours, other than the stipulated hours. In addition, if any such member wishes to play during the stipulated coaching hours, one well maintained practice Pitch shall be made available to them by the successful bidder without any charges.

xix. The successful bidder must sponsor and organise annual Cricket tournaments in Said Area for college staff duly vetted by the competent authority. These include **intra-college and inter-college staff tournaments**. The name of the College shall be displayed prominently in all the publicity materials related to it without any financial obligations from the college.

license agreement. Licensee shall coordinate during the inspection/s. Licensee shall not object to inspection by any authorised person nominated by the college authority and facilitate for the same. The compliance for observations raised during such inspections shall be addressed immediately by the successful bidder.

- xiii. Successful bidder shall not demolish/damage any of the facilities (infrastructure/maintenance) available in the ground, even if that facility has been renovated/repaired/developed on the expiry/cessation/termination license agreement.
- xiv. Successful bidder shall remove all his moveable things, if any, on the expiry/cessation/termination of the contract and/or on expiry of the Contract. The successful bidder shall have no right to enter in the College property including the said area.
- xv. Successful bidder and their coaches shall be allowed for the usage of the parking space in the college campus as per the academy timings.
- xvi. The successful bidder shall be entitled to charge fees/ charges from the students enrolled with the Cricket Academy except those who are regular students of the College. - xx. The successful bidder may organise Cricket tournaments in Said Area, for academy students only after seeking prior permission from college. The name of the College shall be displayed prominently in all the publicity materials related to it without any financial obligations from the college. In case, the tournament is organised beyond allotted/ coaching timings, then prior permissions are to be sought from the College. Further, charges @ Rs. 3000/- per hr. + GST shall be paid by the successful bidder.
- xxi. Other terms and conditions, if any, shall be decided mutually the time of finalizing license agreement (includes an arbitrator clause in case of dispute between the college and licensee).
- xxii. The successful bidder, at their own cost, shall provide valid ID cards to all persons attending the coaching/playing in the Said Area. The particulars of all students/players should be provided to college from time to time.
- xxiii. The successful bidder shall strictly refrain from displaying any kind of advertisement boards/Billboards/banners in the College campus.
