APPOINTMENT OF VICE PRINCIPAL

The appointment to the post of Vice Principal of the College is made for a period of two years in accordance with the Ordinance XVIII clause 4 (4) of Delhi University.

As per Rules (Ordinance XVIII clause 4 (4))

An existing Senior Faculty, who fulfil the Qualifications for the post of Principal may be designated as Vice Principal by the Governing Body of the College on the recommendation of the Principal, for a tenure of two years, who can be assigned specific activities, in addition to concerned faculty member's existing responsibilities. During the absence of the Principal, for any reason, the Vice Principal shall exercise the powers of the Principal. The appointment of such Vice Principal shall require the approval of the University.

The College Governing Body in its 146th meeting held on 24th July, 2023 vide resolution no. 18 appointed Prof. K. Chandramani Singh, Department of Physics, as Vice Principal of the College w.e.f. 1st August, 2023 for a period of two years and the University of Delhi South Campus vide letter No. CS-SDC/149/2023/866, dated 9th August, 2023 conveyed the approval of the University to the appointment of Prof. K. Chandramani Singh, Professor, Department of Physics as Vice Principal of the College w.e.f. 01.08.2023 for a period of two years.

As the term of the Prof. K. Chandramani Singh, Department of Physics, as Vice Principal is going to conclude on 31st July, 2025, the College vide letter no. SVC/Vice Principal/2025/2419, dated 28.07.2025 requested the Hon'ble Chairman, College Governing Body, for his continuance as Vice Principal of the College for another term of two years w.e.f. 1.8.2025 (**Enclosure - 19**)

The College vide order no. SVC/Vice Principal/2025/148-282, dated 28.07.2025 notified that the tenure of Prof. K. Chandramani Singh as Vice Principal of the College is extended till further orders. Subject to approval of the College Governing Body and the University of Delhi (**Enclosure - 20**)

Prof. K. Chandramani Singh, Vice Principal in his letter dated 4th November, 2025 tendered his resignation to the post of Vice Principal w.e.f. the afternoon of 30th November, 2025 so as to enable him to proceed on Sabbatical Leave (**Enclosure - 21**)

The College vide notification no. SVC/Vice Principal/2025, dated 13.11.2025 invited applications from the Senior Faculty of the College, who fulfil the qualifications for the post Principal, to be designated as Vice Principal of the College in accordance XVIII Clause 4 (4) of the Delhi University (**Enclosure - 22**)

In response to the above referred notification the College received 3 (three) applications from the faculty of the College and the details of the applicants are furnished below as per the seniority in the College in accordance with the Statute 37 of Delhi University.

TO CONSIDER THE PAYMENT OF LOWER RATE OF INTEREST TO THE GPF SUBSCRIBERS IN THE EVENT OF GETTING LOWER RATE OF INTEREST ON THE INVESTMENT OF PF FROM THE NATIONALIZED BANKS

The funds accumulated under the Provident Fund Scheme are invested with Banks in the form of Fixed Deposit Receipts (FDR) and the interest earned from such FDRs is credited to the individual P.F. Accounts of the employees.

Earlier, the interest rates were very high and the FDRs used to yield as high as 12%, accordingly, provision was made at high rates in the employees individual P.F, accounts. Thus, there used to be surplus in the P.F. interest accounts.



However, the interest rates started falling sharply and the yield on our investments came down to as low as 5.5% per annum. As desired by the members and in accordance with Government of India norms and the practices prevailing in other similarly placed institutions, provision for interest was made as per the rates announced by the Government from time to time; but never more than that @8% per annum.

The shortfall thus arising was met out of the brought forward surplus in the P.F. interest account. As a result, the brought forward surplus in the PF interest account was wiped out and as on 31.03.2025, there is a deficit in the P. F. Account amounting to Rs.1,01,91,996/-

Till recent times, the College is managing the payment of interest to the subscribers as determined by the Govt. of India, from the surplus in the Provident fund account (accrued in the previous years) though the rates of interest of the banks have fallen down very drastically.

Keeping in view of this issue, the College vide letter no. SVC/Provident Funds/2025/149-45, dated 02.12.2025, requested the University of Delhi to compensate the difference between the interest receipts on our FDRs and the interest rates on GPF as is being fixed by the Government of India and in turn the University of Delhi provided a copy of the letter No.F.30-3/2003 (CU), dated 27.04.2004 received from the Deputy Secretary, University Grant Commission for reference and necessary action

According to the letter UGC,

- it is mandatory to follow the rate of interest notified by the Government.
- lesser rate of interest can be paid depending upon the financial position of the institution, but higher rate of interest cannot be paid
- quite obviously, the budget of an institution can in no case be augmented in order to meet the shortfall between the interest liability of the institution on PF subscription and the income earned on the investment of Provident fund.
- in the circumstances, *in the event of shortfall between the interest liability of an institution on PF subscription and the income earned on the investment of Provident Fund, an institution would have no option but to pay interest at lesser rate, unless financial position of the institution permits to follow the rate interest notified by the Government.*

The Governing Body may please peruse the case and advise on the rate of interest to be paid to the G.P.F. subscribers w.e.f. 01.01.2026.

RESOLUTION: Approved to pay the rate of interest to subscribers at par with interest earned on Provident Fund investment by duly adjusting the accumulated deficit and advised the College to review the situation from time to time in consultation of the Management.

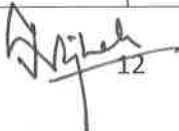
